

HOUSE RECOMMENDATION

WHITE

1. Maréchal France

Medium Chenin Blanc

Vin de France [3]

A clean, fresh, well balanced off dry wine with refreshing fruit character showing through to it's long lasting finish.

2. Mánnara Italy

Grillo/Pinot Grigio

Sicilia IGT

A dry, easy-drinking Sicilian white with a floral aroma and flavours of citrus, apple, pear, vanilla and almonds.

3. Gran Hacienda Chile

Sauvignon Blanc

Santa Rita, Lontué Valley

Crisp and refreshing, with aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel lending a fresh balance to the tropical fruit character, plus some herbal notes from a drop of Semillon in the blend. Vibrant and well-rounded.

RED

4. Mon Roc France

Merlot/Carignan

Vin de France [B]

A ruby appearance with a hint of spicy Carignan on the nose. Full on the palate without being too heavy. Typical of young wines from the South of France.

5. Santa Alvara Chile

Merlot

Chile

Fresh, attractive nose dominated by ripe fruit notes - plum, cherry, cassis and blackberry - with a hint of spice. Medium-bodied and smooth with discreet oaky notes on the palate.

6. Gran Hacienda Chile

Cabernet Sauvignon

Santa Rita, Central Valley

Elegant and balanced, with a fruity aroma dominated by berries, cloves and vanilla, while on the palate it delivers fine concentration, suggesting juicy ripe fruit, plums, earth and leather.

ROSE

7. Fontaine De La Tour France

Syrah-Rosé

Vin de France

A fresh, easy drinking rose packed with red fruit flavours. The syrah offers delicately perfumed, spicy notes and dry, crisp finish.

8. Stone Cellars United States

Zinfandel Rosé

Beringer Vineyards, California

Fruity aromas and flavours of ripe strawberries and some spicy clove/nutmeg notes. Soft, well-rounded palate, in a medium style.

WHITE WINE

10. Concha y Toro Chardonnay

Chile [2]

Straw yellow, vibrant, fresh and fruity with a surprisingly long clean finish. A typical unoaked New World Chardonnay.

11. Old Coach Road Chardonnay

New Zealand [2]

Subtle oak on the nose with tropical, apricot and citrus fruits. Well balanced with fresh acidity and a little oak on the finish.

12. Coopers Creek Sauvignon Blanc

Marlborough, New Zealand

On the nose there is masses of passionfruit and nectarine, along with herbal nuances. On the palate it is full-bodied for a Sauvignon, with a mid-palate richness and loads of fruit on the finish.

WHITE CONNOISSEUR SELECTION

13. Seifried Estate Gewurztraminer

New Zealand [2]

Subtle Gewurztraminer with nice spice character and good balance. Round and full in style, drinks nicely with slightly spicy foods.

14. Foucher Lebrun Sancerre Le Mont

Loire, France

Crisp, flavoursome Sancerre which offers floral and boxwood aromas. The palate shows juicy citrus fruit alongside the trademark elegance and minerality of the appellation.

15. Pouilly Fuisse Cuvée A L'Ancienne

France [2]

Pale lemon yellow in colour with steely Chardonnay nose. The taste is quite rich with good depth and length of flavour.

16. Chablis Chateau de Viviers

France [1]

Classic elegant Chardonnay with attractive fruit characters with rich mineral flavours and excellent length.

17. Vincent Girardin Meursault Vieilles Vignes

Burgundy, France

This wine is a restrained style of Meursault, quite focused and clean with a slightly floral finish.

RED WINE

18. Ocean Point
Shiraz **Australia** [C]
Vibrant and fruity with aromas of raspberry and spice. Soft and supple with smooth tannins and plenty of berry fruit flavours.
19. Marques de Caceres
Crianza Rioja **Spain** [B]
A fresh, fruity bouquet of raspberries and cherries with a soft touch of vanilla and spice. Full with smooth tannins and a fleshy finish.
20. Cono Sur Maiden Flight Reserve
Pinot Noir **Chile** [C]
Attractive savoury Pinot Noir. Barrel aged producing nice soft tannins and smooth cherry fruit flavours with good balance and length.

RED CONNOISSEUR SELECTION

21. Martinez Bujanda
Promesa Rioja Reserva
Spain
Delicious velvety Rioja which, after five years maturing, is showing its sophisticated savoury side as well as rich berry fruit and subtle oak influence.
22. Chateauneuf du Pape
Galets Roules
France [D]
Delicious, warm, rich fruit flavours. Excellent quality with soft supple tannins.
23. Masi
Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2007
Veneto, Italy
Bright and intense on the nose with aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with hints of fruits of the forest and cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate, opening out to attractive aromas of cherries and vanilla.
24. Marchesi Antinori
Tignanello
Toscana IGT, Italy
Concentrated with ripe red fruit and spice aromas, as well as vanilla and toasty notes from the oak. The palate, while still youthful, is powerful and complex.

ROSE WINE

26. Olive Hills Pinot Grigio Rose
Italy [3]
Light rose colour. Delicate fresh fruit character with nice mineral notes. Medium dry and very refreshing.

SPARKLING WINE & CHAMPAGNE

28. Ombrina Pinot Spumante
The Wine People, Veneto, Italy
Delightfully light, elegant sparkling Pinot Grigio, with pear & melon fruit, delicate bubbles, and a crisp finish.
29. Portaceli Cava Brut
Spain
A fine, persistent mousse. Medium in body with soft, fresh fruit.
30. René Barbier Cava Rosado Brut
Spain
Vibrant in colour and aroma, full of raspberry and redcurrant fruit, delicate bubbles and an attractive dry finish.
31. Yves Lallement Brut NV **France**
Dry with attractive fruit and yeasty flavours and excellent balance.
32. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label
Brut NV France
A deep biscuity nose, plenty of fruit, dry with fine balance and style.
33. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé **France**
A delicate rosé, light and refreshing with flowery, fragrant character and hints of summer fruits on both the nose and palate.
34. Dom Perignon **France**
One of Champagne's most outstanding wines. Refined with a palate showing layers of yeasty, nutty flavours.
35. Louis Roederer Crystal **France**
A most distinguished Champagne with plenty of flavour.
36. Dom Perignon Rose 2000 **France**
